

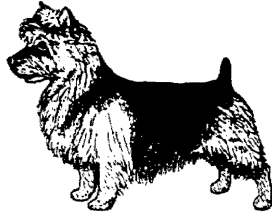

## **ATTENTION EXHIBITORS**

### **Welcome to Flatirons Kennel Club, Inc. Dog Shows & the National Specialty of The Australian Terrier Club of America, Inc.!**

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors & specialty clubs at 4:30 pm - 6:00 pm on Thursday, May 30, 2019 & at 7:00 am Friday, May 31, 2019. All buildings will close at 11:00 pm Friday & Saturday and reopen on Saturday & Sunday at 6:00 am. All dogs, exhibitors & set ups must be out of the Fairgrounds Buildings 1/2 hour after Best in Show on Sunday.

Security personnel will be on duty from 11:00 pm until 6:00 am, Friday & Saturday nights.

Except for the Campground, which is run by Boulder County Fairgrounds & Dry Camping, the show site will NOT be available before 7:00 am on Friday.

#### **DOG SHOW PARKING**

Unloading & loading only are permitted in the Parking lot west of the Exhibit Building. Anyone parking in this lot without a permit, or in ANY fire lane in any lot WILL BE TOWED at the owner's expense.

**LOT A** - Only vans & cars are allowed to park in Lot A (south parking lot). No set ups (exercise pens, crates, or grooming tables) are allowed in Lot A. Saving space in any Lot is not permitted.

**LOT B** - Non-electric and dry camping overnight parking will be available ONLY in Lot B and NOT before 7:00 am on Thursday. A \$10.00 fee per night for parking in Lot B will be collected. Exhibitors who are dry camping in Lot B are not entitled to use the showers in the Exhibit Building or the Campgrounds. All waste water must be retained and disposed of properly. ANY VEHICLE PARKED IN LOT B WILL NOT UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES BE ALLOWED TO USE ELECTRICAL OR WATER HOOKUPS. ANY VIOLATION WILL BE SUBJECT TO EVENT COMMITTEE JURISDICTION.

**OVERNIGHT RV PARKING WITH HOOK-UPS** - The Only parking facility that has hookups is an RV Parking Campground, operated by Boulder County Fairgrounds. Electricity, showers, restrooms and dump station are available. This campground is located approximately 800 feet from the Exhibit Building. The Campground is operated on a First Come First Served basis, there are no reservations available.

Prices may vary with your needs and are subject to change at any time. The Campgrounds office will provide you with all the information concerning their fees, rules, and regulations.

Grooming within the perimeter of the campground is subject to Campground rules and regulations. Should any problems arise with overnight guests, Boulder County Fairgrounds reserves the right to ask the offenders to leave the Fairgrounds. If the problem is brought to the attention of Flatirons Kennel Club, Inc. it will result in an Event Committee Hearing being called.

Please be courteous to all parking personnel.

**ALL OBEDIENCE & RALLY CLASSES WILL BE JUDGED INDOORS ON A DIRT FLOOR.**

**CLEAN UP IN THE RING & ON THE SHOW GROUNDS IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE EXHIBITOR. RING STEWARDS WILL BE GLAD TO HOLD YOUR DOG WHILE YOU CLEAN UP.**

There is no space provided for unentered dogs at these shows.

Puppies under 6 months of age are not allowed on the show grounds except for Metro Mile Hi Kennel Club, LTD. 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Class Entrants. Selling of puppies on the show grounds is strictly forbidden.

There will be a paramedic on duty during show hours on Friday, Saturday & Sunday.

Emergency Veterinary care will be available at THE ANIMAL EMERGENCY CENTER, beginning Friday evening at 5:00 pm. They are located at 104 S Main or call (303) 678-8844.

Some grooming is by reservation only (see page 15). Non-reserved grooming is available in Barns A, B & C. Roping off or saving space in any non-reserved grooming is prohibited. Any ropes, mats, electric cords, etc used in this manner will be removed by the show committee. Floor mats & exercise pens are not allowed in ANY building. Please stack crates & limit grooming tables to allow space for all exhibitors. Exhibitors must be responsible for the cleanliness of their area.

**Dogs are not allowed in restrooms. Bathing of dogs will be allowed in designated areas only.**

Double handling will not be permitted at these shows. Offenders will be subject to action by the Events Committee.

The welfare of an exhibitor's child is the responsibility of the exhibitor. It is expressly understood that the exhibitor will exercise control & restraint over their children while they are on the show premises.

NO STROLLERS ARE ALLOWED IN ANY BUILDING!! This is for the safety of your child & will be enforced. Skateboards, roller blades & heeies are prohibited.

We are unable to provide chairs ringside, so please bring your own!

Aisles must be kept clear! There is no crating or grooming allowed in the aisles.

Boulder County does not permit smoking in any County facility.

The Exhibit Building is climate controlled. Please conserve energy by keeping doors closed.

**PUBLICATION RIGHTS:** By entering this show, all owners, handlers, breeders and kennels agree that all rights to televise, videotape, photograph, advertise, promote and publicize or otherwise exploit this show, or the persons or animals participating in it or the results of the competition before, during or after the event, shall belong solely to The American Kennel Club and their respective assigns, including the use of the names, likenesses or biographical matter of all dogs, owners, handlers, breeders and kennels participating in the show and no such owner, handler, breeder or kennel shall allow any other party to make commercial use of any videotape or photograph of any person or animal participating in this competition.

**NEW EXHIBITOR BRIEFING** on Saturday. Check Judging Program for time & location.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 1st Entry & \$3.00 additional entry of same dog will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.**

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

**RETURNED CHECKS/DECLINED CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a fee for completing the transaction and/or reprocessing the entries. Repeated occurrences from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

The show giving Club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

**EXHIBITORS NOTE:** Please notify Superintendent of any change of address.

## AKC NATIONAL OWNER-HANDLED SERIES

The AKC National Owner-Handled Series is a non-titling competition for dogs that are exhibited by their owners that are not professional handlers.

All dogs that are owner-handled and are not exhibited in the National Owner-Handled Series by professional handlers\* meet the requirements for this competition. Exhibitors must declare their dog is Owner-Handled eligible at the time of entry using the check box on the entry form. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the steward's book & the catalog. **Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers, household members and current assistants to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any AKC National Owner-Handled Series competition during the entire show. A current assistant is defined by anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis, or assisting a professional handler at the show or any show during the cluster/weekend, however current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age and amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.**

Owner-Handled Best of Breed will be selected from the dogs that are competing in the Best of Breed competition including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch and winners of the non-regular classes.

*\*Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years.*

## **FUTURITY NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS & RULES**

The Futurity is sponsored by The Australian Terrier Club of America, Inc. and is exclusively for the competition of Junior, Intermediate and Senior dogs and bitches between 6 months and 24 months of age in conjunction with the National Specialty. It is primarily a showcase for breeders of Australian Terriers.

The Futurity is open to all breeders of AKC registered Australian Terriers in good standing with the American Kennel Club.

The breeder is responsible for nominating the bitch for the appropriate Futurity (offspring from 6 months to 24 months old). The breeder is also responsible for returning the nominating forms and associated fees to the Futurity Chairperson. Late fees will apply if the litter is nominated after 10 weeks of age.

### **NOMINATION PROCEDURE AND FORMS**

The Official Bitch Nomination Form, along with the fee of \$50.00 is to be mailed to the Futurity Chairperson. The Bitch Nomination Form may be obtained from the Futurity Chairperson or obtained from The Australian Terrier Club of America, Inc. website.

The Official Litter Nomination Form for nominated bitches should be returned by the Futurity Chairperson along with the fee of \$25.00 and a three-generation pedigree (for the catalog).

The Official Puppy Nomination Form including the fee of \$10.00 must be returned to Futurity Chairperson no later than one month to the date of the ATCA National Specialty.

### **FUTURITY ENTRIES**

To enter the Futurity, puppies must be entered in a regular conformation class and the appropriate futurity class as an 'additional' class at the ATCA National they were nominated and are eligible for.

The Futurity Chairperson collects the nomination forms and fees. The Show Superintendent collects entry fees and additional class fees.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Puppies are only eligible to be shown in one Futurity; the first Futurity when they are at least 6 months of age and no older than 24 months, Champions of Record are eligible, breeder/owner/non-professional exhibitor must show the dog. If a professional handler owns the dog but is not the breeder, they are ineligible to show the dog. If the professional handler bred the dog, of course, they are eligible to show the dog.

### **CLASSES**

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches.

6 Mos & Under 12 Mos • 12 Mos & Under 18 Mos • 18 Mos & Under 24 Mos

The winner of each class will compete for Best Dog and Best Bitch in Futurity.

*PREFACE: The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
